

Northern Germany's Schleswig-Holstein

Day 1: Thursday, June 30, 2022• Departure

Our journey begins as we board our international flight bound for Hamburg, Germany. **Inflight meals**

Day 2: Friday, July 1, 2022 ● Hamburg – Schleswig – Flensburg

Upon our arrival in Hamburg, we meet our coach driver and tour guide and drive northeast into the German state of Schleswig-Holstein. Our first stop is the town of Schleswig which takes its name from the Schlei, an inlet of the Baltic sea where Schleswig sits. A local guide introduces us to the town and its history. We are also inspired by the Schleswig-Holstein State Museum at Gottorf Castle in Schleswig that impresses us with its rich art collections and the reconstruction of a walk back in time. Afterwards, we

continue to nearby Flensburg where we have an early dinner at a local establishment. **B, D**

Day 3: Saturday, July 2, 2022 • Flensburg

Today we explore Flensburg and the surrounding area. A local guide introduces us to the town and its history. Located on the German Danish border it has both German and Danish influence. Today's highlights include a harbor cruise, visit to the harbor museum as well as the Rum Museum and a sample too! **B**

Day 4: Sunday, July 3, 2022 ● Fehmarn Island – Burg Fehmarn

After breakfast we depart for Fehmarn Island for a day back in time. We visit the Open-Air Museum of Katharinenhof and the Peter Wiepert

Day 6: Tuesday, July 5, 2022 • Lübeck

After breakfast, a local guide joins us as for a walking tour of the city. Everywhere we turn is a photo stop as we gaze upon the city's brick towers and gates. We have an opportunity to sample some of the marzipan. By

some accounts marzipan was invented in Lübeck. We also visit the Willie Brandt Haus and the European Hanse Museum. **B, D**
