IMPORTANT TRAVEL UPDATES

ETIAS - New travel requirements for Europe! Starting in 2024 US citizens will be required to apply for a Travel Authorization to enter most European countries. Be sure to check the country you wish to visit for their travel requirements. Applications are not being accepted yet. But when this requirement goes into effect, you will need to apply if you have a trip planned for Europe in 2024.

ETIAS travel authorization is an entry requirement for US citizens traveling to most of the European countries. It is linked to a traveler's passport. It is valid for up to three years or until the passport expires. With a valid ETIAS travel authorization, you can enter the territory of the European country as often as you want for short term stays - normally up to 90 days in any 180 period. However it does not guarantee entry. When you arrive, a border guard will ask to see your passport and documents and verify that you meet the entry conditions.

You can fill out the application form using the official ETIAS website or the ETIAS mobile application. Cost is 7 Euros. Most applications are processed in minutes. Although it is possible to take longer. You should receive a decision within 4 days. However if additional information is requested this period could be extended up 14 days. Or even 30 days if you are invited in for an interview. So apply well in advance of your trip.

Once you have applied you will receive an email confirming the submission which will include your unique ETIAS application number. After it is processed you will receive confirmation. Make sure your name, passport number and other information is correct. If your application is refused the email will provide the reasons why and you will need to appeal.

REAL ID Driver's License - Date has been extended to May 5, 2025. Check with your DMV for requirements.
